Associate Chaplain Job Qualifications

- Be a duly ordained, licensed or endorsed through a church or church related group.
- Be willing to engage in ministry focused on law enforcement officers. Law enforcement chaplaincy and jailhouse ministries are considered a conflict of interest. Serving you own parishioner, who becomes imprisoned is not considered a conflict of interest.
- Five years in the ministry.
- Successfully pass a criminal background check.
- Possess a valid driver's license.
- Possess high ethical and morale standards.
- Be tactful.
- Possess the ability to work with a number of faith groups.
- Possess good judgment.
- Terms of appointment are at-will. Appointments are made by the F.O.P. Board of Trustees or its designee.
- Preference given to applicants who are actively volunteering as a police department chaplain; exceptions will be made on a case-by-case basis.
