NPA works by storing images of children, the elderly, and persons of interest for the purpose of immediate distribution to all law enforcement and alert recipients within a geographic-specific zone. Having direct access to a photograph and critical information of a missing person will drastically increase the likelihood of recovery.

Currently, we are seeing our members sign up as Alert Recipients all across the country. As this is extremely exciting as we begin to build the alert recipient database of this revolutionary missing person recovery network, I am asking for your help in registering your members, family and friends as both Alert Recipients and protecting your loved ones as Customers.

I am requesting that you sign up at least **25 Alert Recipients and Customers**. They can be family, friends and fellow members. This is happening all over the country. I have also included a letter for you to give to your local lodge members if necessary.
